

# ANDREW JENKIN



Born in 1976 and originally from Crewe in Cheshire, Andrew Jenkin lives and works as an artist in Huddersfield. He spent three years at Keele University in Staffordshire where he obtained an Honours degree in History and Ancient History.

Working from his studio in nineteenth-century Brooke's Mill at Armitage Bridge, Andrew produces greetings cards, bookmarks and prints from his watercolours, many of which depict well-known buildings and landmarks around the north of England in a variety of styles, from detailed pen-and-ink washes to bright watercolours and colourful mixed media work. Andrew has recently written and illustrated a children's book about the Lambton Worm, a folk-tale from the North-East of England. An exhibition of the original illustrations for the book is currently touring across the North of England.

Andrew is also a Vice President of the Huddersfield Art Society.
